Dear Team Manager:

Thank you for your entry for the SEAA Road Relay Championships on Sunday 29 March at **Stantonbury Campus Athletics Stadium**, Milton Keynes (**MK14 6BN**). I enclose a map of the area. Please park in one of the Campus car parks. The car park at the end of Soskin Drive is reserved for officials (to avoid excessive car traffic across the course during the race). There will be signs pointing to the track from the Campus car parks.

There is **changing accommodation** and showers at the track in the clubhouse. There will be additional **toilets** on the site to supplement those in the clubhouse. The upstairs toilets in the clubhouse will be reserved for officials. Please do **not** leave **kit/bags** in the changing rooms – they can be left by your tent/banner on the infield or banking.

I also enclose a map of the **course**. Note that there are a number of **bollards** on the redways and footpaths round the course and, while there has not yet been an accident, it is worth pointing out to your runners that they need to be vigilant.

Please note, the SEAA Road Race Management Committee has stated that **Under 17 athletes** won't be allowed to take part in these Championships (i.e. athletes must be 17 or over on 1 September 2014).

We are pleased to be able to say that **tents** and **banners** can be erected on the track infield and on the banking.

The **Registration Desk** will be in the clubhouse close to the Start/Finish area. You will be able to pick up a package containing your numbers and the **team declaration sheets**. The men's team declarations must be completed and returned by 11.30am and the women by 12.30pm. The men's 12-stage race starts at 12 noon and the women's 6-stage race at 1pm. For the men's race, any runners who have not started their legs by 4.30pm will be sent off together at that time with the final positions and times of their teams adjusted accordingly. This will ensure that the race finishes by 5pm.

Refreshments will be available in the clubhouse. Each team will be given a pack of water bottles.

A computer program has been developed for processing the **results** that will, we hope, enable us to get results out quickly. These results will be posted in the clubhouse and on the event website at <http://www.seaarelays.org.uk> throughout the afternoon, as each leg is completed.

The **women's presentation** will be held on the clubhouse steps at 3.45pm. The **men's presentation** will be held there at 5.15pm (if not before!). Teams will only be eligible for the men's and women's spot prizes if there is at least one member present at the presentation.

I look forward to seeing you on the day and to another exciting Championship.


